Over the last several years, teachers at Greenock Elementary in our district, have done an amazing job in supporting the neediest in our community. We have in place a community garden that is farmed by our elementary students at Greenock. In conjunction with the garden, we started a summer enrichment class called, "Little Sprouts", where children learn about growing and cultivating the garden.
