**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF O'HARA INDICATING THE  
INTENT TO WORK ALONG WITH ALLEGHENY COUNTY TO  
ACCOMPLISH THE GOALS OF THE *LIVE WELL ALLEGHENY*  
CAMPAIGN**

WHEREAS, Allegheny County Executive Rich Fitzgerald, under the leadership of the Board of Health and Health Department, launched a comprehensive, innovative strategy on wellness called *Live Well Allegheny* in January of 2014; and

WHEREAS, living well is a broad concept that incorporates physical health, mental wellness, physical activity, nutrition, fitness, managing chronic disease, improving well-being, quality of life, education, cessation programs, vaccinations, weight loss, anti-aging, health literacy and so much more; and

WHEREAS, the health of our county residents, and the health of Township of O'Hara residents requires a coordinated effort to ensure that programs, studies, outreach events and other efforts have the ability to improve our overall health; behavioral changes require a cultural change which *Live Well Allegheny* is intent on providing; and

WHEREAS, one of the main initiatives of the *Live Well Allegheny* campaign is to endeavor to have the participation of all 130 municipalities and to provide programming in each of those communities to enhance the capacity of effective planning, implementation, evaluation and sustainable activities and interventions that accomplish the goals.


